

#### Impact of Global Recession

Same Tax Rate on Property Valued 9% Lower: \$174 Million Less

 Combined with Reductions in Sales Taxes, Drop in Interest Earned, and Inflationary Costs: \$350 to \$400 Million Funding Gap

 "Expenditure reductions of this magnitude could require the complete elimination of some departments and programs." June 1 Memo

### Budget Challenge for FY 09-10

Miami-Dade County has an overall Budget this year of @ \$7.5 Billion The Operating Budget is @\$5 Billion \$2.3 Billion of the Operating Budget is Tax Supported (Non-Proprietary) The \$350-\$400 Million "Shortfall" affects the Tax Supported Operating Budget – 15% Reduction
